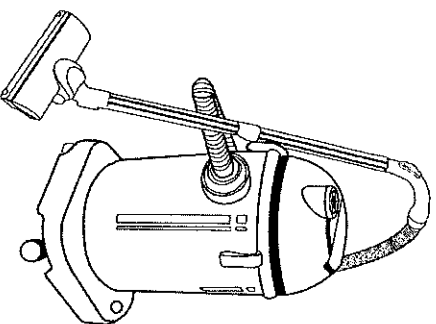

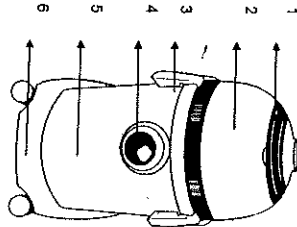

PARTS DESCRIPTION

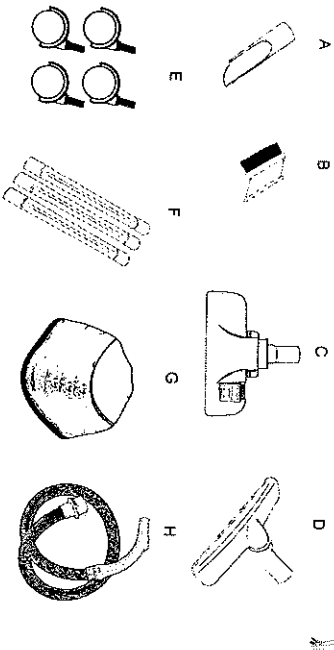
- 1) Handle
- 2) Top Cover
- 3) Clamp
- 4) Suction Inlet
- 5) Tank
- 6) Base

- C) Master Nozzle (for Dry)
- D) Squeeze Nozzle (for Wet)
- E) Wheel/Roller
- F) Extension Wands
- G) Filter Bag
- H) Flexible Hose

BEFORE USING

- Please read these instructions carefully before use and keep them for future reference.
- Check your local main voltage whether it is the same as stated on the rating label.
- Before using, remove any protective films or stickers from the product.
- Ensure the power button is at the off position.
- Never use a vacuum cleaner near to the sink, bathtub or shower etc, which is filled with water.

INSTALLATION OF WHEELS/ROLLERS

Step by step wheels/rollers installation:

- i. Gently push to insert wheel's metal bolts about 1.5cm directly into the wheel's holder/hole at vacuum cleaner's base.
- ii. Apply controlled force/pressure to insert the remaining portion of the wheel metal bolt into the base wheel holder
- iii. Repeat the above 2 step for the remaining 3 wheels to complete the wheel fastening process.

Caution:
Inserting the wheel's metal bolt at wrong angle or using excessive force will damages to the wheel holder of the vacuum base

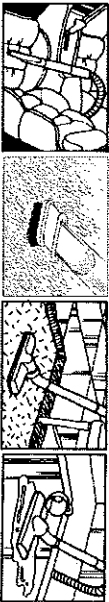
OPERATIONS

- Release the clamp before you remove the top cover from the tank.
- Insert the filter bag.
- Fasten the clamps after installed the top cover on the tank.
- It can be used for wet, dry and blow functions.



APPLICATION FOR DIFFERENT PURPOSE

- Use the crevice nozzle for corner and track
- Use the ellipse brush for surface such as lampshades, air conditioner grills, car dashboard, etc.
- Use the master nozzle for carpet floor / surfaces
- Use the squeeze nozzle for wet surfaces

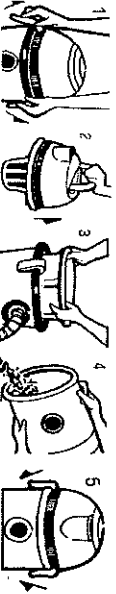


CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

- Always unplug the product from wall socket and let it cool down completely prior to cleaning. Do not leave the vacuum cleaner unattended when plugged in.
- Do not use abrasive sponges, scouring pads or stiff brush to clean the appliance.
- Please be cautious when cleaning the product near to the motor housing area.
- Use only damp cloth to wipe the exterior surfaces of the unit. Do not immerse the main body in water.
- Do not allow the motor or other electrical components to be exposed to water.
- For proper storage, always place the vacuum cleaner in a low humidity environment.

HOW TO DISPOSE GARBAGE & WATER

1. Release the side clamps
2. Remove the top cover.
3. Remove the filter bag from the tank. The filter bag is washable.
4. Empty the garbage (dust/water) from the tank
5. Fasten with the side clamps



Note:

Do not clean the filter bag with washing machine as it will damage the filter bag. Hand wash with water only and dry under the Sun instead.

IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

- To ensure the efficient performance of the machine, please clean the filter bag & tank after each used.
- Use only original accessories supplies.
- The current voltage which indicates on the plate must correspond to your local voltage.
- Never operate unit unless it's fully assembly.
- Do not operate the appliance if the power supply cord or plug have be damaged.
- Do not immerse the cord, plug, or appliance in water or other types of liquid and do not pour water into it to avoid fire, electric shock or personal injury.
- To protect against risk of electric shock, do not force any foreign objects such as pins and wires into openings.
- Do not pull the cord to remove the plug from wall socket, pull on the plug instead.
- Do not attempt to insert or remove the plug with wet hands.
- Do not place the appliance on or near to hot gas / electric burner or a heated oven.
- In the event not use appliance for a long period of time, please remove the plug from the power outlet.
- Do not allow the motor or other electrical components to be exposed to water.
- Do not vacuum flammable substances and also avoid vacuuming sharp objects that could obstruct the hose.
- Always use the vacuum cleaner horizontally positioned, otherwise water may enter the motor and damage the appliance.
- Do not use it to vacuum inflammable or corrosive liquids such as petrol or other volatile substances.
- Be sure to operate the wet/dry vacuum cleaner with filter bag inside.
- Do not operate any appliance with damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or been damaged in any manner. Repair and service should always be carried out by qualified service personnel only.

TROUBLE SHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause & Solution
The machine does not start	Please ensure the power cord, plug socket is plugged in correctly and the switch is on.
The suction power reduce	The maximum level of dust or water collector has reached the limit. Please clean the filter bag and empty the tank.
Heat from machine	Hot air/heat generated from the machine is normal. Please keep the machine cool down if continuous operate for a long period of time.
